1. **Farmin' - "Milk" it for all its worth!** Bought flowers may be used.
Trophy awarded for first place.
2. **Corn** - Make a hanging door arrangement using dried corn and other dried materials.
3. **Apples** - Dining table centerpiece incorporating apples
4. **Eggs** - "All your eggs in one basket"-a white and yellow arrangement
5. **Kitchen Garden** - An edible arrangement
6. **Firelight** - Miniature dried arrangement on a candlestick. Arrangement not to exceed 6"x6"x6"

7. "September Bride"-Brides bouquet and matching boutonniere. Tag your entry with your business card. Trophy awarded for 1st place.
